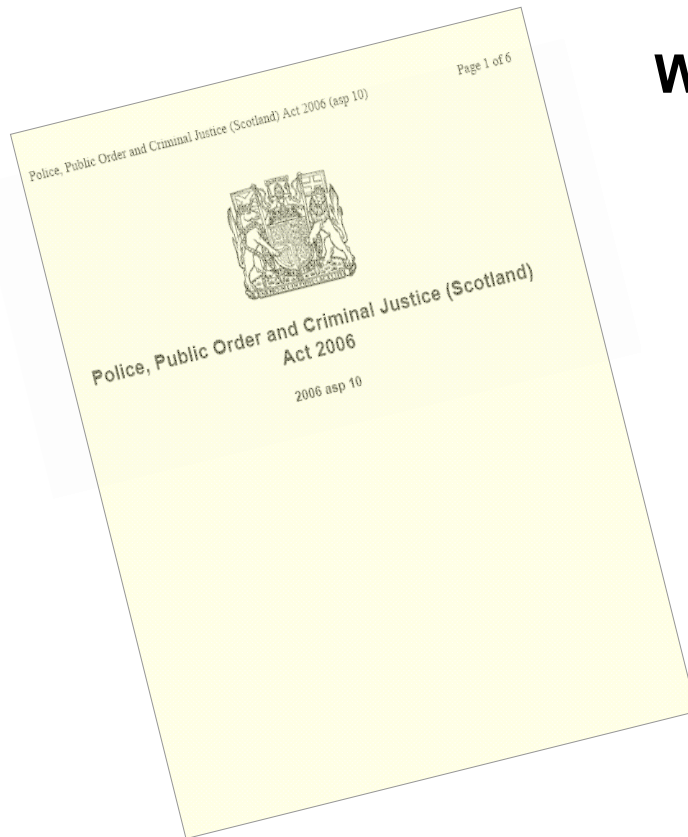

PCCS - Commissioner's Role

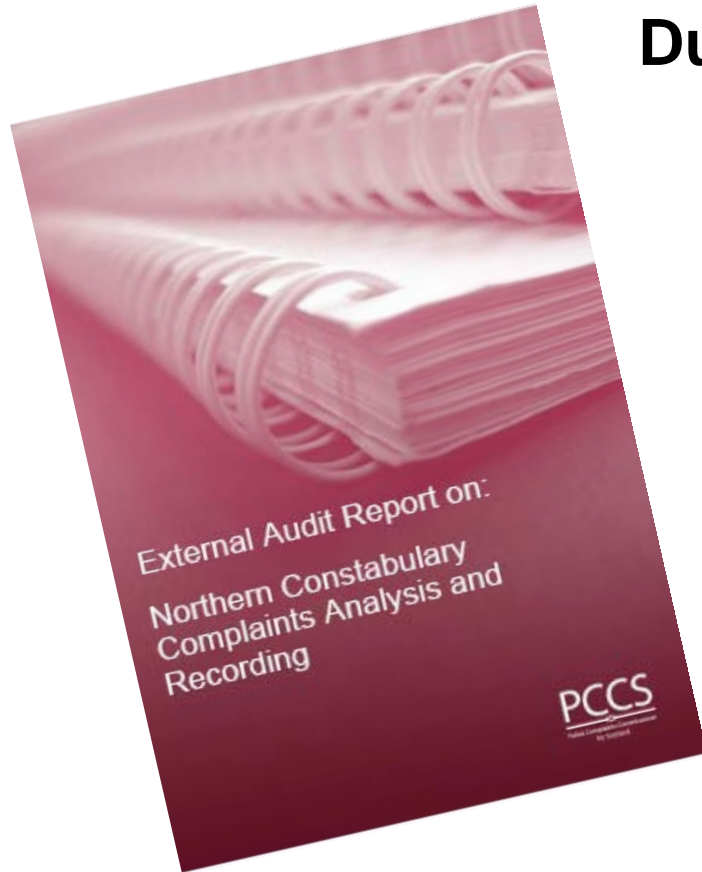


Wide ranging remit;

- Review the way that complaints are handled
- Secure and review effective and efficient procedures
- Issue recommendations & guidance to relevant authorities
- Report “grave” or “serious” concerns to Ministers



PCCS – Providing reassurance



Duty to secure efficient and effective police complaint handling

- Work with Convenor's Forum
- Establish current capability
 - Governance arrangements
 - Oversight arrangements
 - Composition
 - Frequency
 - Operational practices and procedures
